

PRIVATE LESSONS 2023-2024

Bedford Patrons of Music Students (POMS) is pleased to offer private music lessons to interested Bedford Students/Residents. This packet contains information about private lessons and instrument rentals, as well as a registration form for the current year. Once your registration and payment are received, POMS will assign your teacher(s). The teacher(s) will contact you before the trimester begins to schedule your lessons.

BASIC INFORMATION

LOCATION: Lessons are generally held at the Bedford Public Schools, depending on room availability. lessons are in person; some teachers do offer remote lessons.

TIMING: Students may choose thirty, forty-five, or sixty-minute lessons. Lessons are typically held between 3:00pm and 8:00pm on weekdays.

INSTRUCTORS: POMS contracts with a select group of professional musicians and music teachers to provide the best possible experience for students. If you would like to request a particular teacher, please indicate that on the registration form, and we'll make every effort to accommodate the request.

COST: Lessons are organized into three trimesters of ten lessons each. Lessons are pro-rated, depending on length, at a rate of \$54/hour (see the registration form for more details). An annual registration fee of \$15 for the program year also applies for all students (\$25 per family, for more than one student or instrument), and a late fee of \$10 will be charged for any payment received after the deadlines listed below. **If you need financial assistance for lessons, please indicate that in the box at the bottom of the registration form.**

LESSON POLICIES

BEDFORD RESIDENTS ONLY.

PAYMENT is due at the start of each trimester, on the dates noted above.

MISSED LESSONS are highly discouraged. Students must contact the teacher at least 24 hours in advance to arrange for a make-up lesson during the same trimester. Lessons missed for reasons other than illness or family emergency will be considered unexcused and cannot be made up. <u>Refunds will not be given for unused lessons</u>.

TRANSPORTATION is not provided to or from lessons. Parents or guardians must arrange for student dropoff and pickup and are strongly encouraged to be present for the duration of the lesson. Teachers or school employees are not responsible for unaccompanied students before or after lessons.

INSTRUMENT RENTAL is the responsibility of the student. A list of recommended instrument suppliers is on the back of this page.
